COMPLAINT

I. INTRODUCTION

- 1. When Michaela Carter's estranged husband, Defendant James Leggett, beat her with a glass liquor bottle in July 2021, Ms. Carter did exactly what she was supposed to do: she contacted law enforcement and obtained an order of protection against him. See Ex. 1. Ms. Carter's order of protection prominently advised that if Defendant Leggett came around her, threatened her, or bothered her while the order of protection was in effect—or if he violated the order of protection by carrying a gun—Defendant Leggett could "be arrested by the Police Department on the spot." *Id.* at 1.
- 2. On November 15, 2021, Defendant Leggett set out looking for Ms. Carter at a family member's apartment building. In violation of both Ms. Carter's order of protection and state and federal criminal law prohibiting a convicted felon from carrying a firearm, Defendant Leggett was visibly armed. Defendant Leggett's intent was to find Ms. Carter and kill her.

- 3. While looking for Ms. Carter, Defendant Leggett called and texted Ms. Carter repeatedly. Defendant Leggett's text messages to Ms. Carter included at least one photo of himself with Ms. Carter. They also included revenge pornography depicting Defendant Leggett and Ms. Carter. As a result, Defendant Leggett's text message correspondence made plain to any reader that Defendant Leggett was, in fact, the person who was contacting Ms. Carter in violation of her order of protection against him.
- 4. While looking for Ms. Carter, Defendant Leggett posted a series of ominous and deeply disturbing Facebook posts, including statements like: "Today is the day" and "Somebody with nothing to lose won't give a fuck When Shit gets real don't ask me why."
- 5. Terrified for her life based on Defendant Leggett's behavior, Ms. Carter and her mother pulled over and called 911. When MNPD officers arrived, Ms. Carter informed them that Defendant Leggett "was walking around [a family member's] apartment building with a gun." *See* Ex. 2 at 18. Ms. Carter also showed the officers her order of protection against Leggett, which the officers "verified with DCSO" was both genuine and in effect. *Id.* Ms. Carter additionally showed the officers Leggett's barrage of disturbing text messages and Facebook posts, and she begged the officers to arrest Leggett before he murdered her.
- 6. Under these circumstances, the responding officers had a legal duty to arrest Leggett pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 36-3-611. They failed to satisfy this duty.
- 7. Instead, the officers did not take the situation seriously and privately joked about it. They also falsely asserted that they could not arrest Defendant Leggett based on the information they had been provided, and they inaccurately instructed Ms. Carter that she would have to "go downtown" to swear out a warrant if she wanted Defendant Leggett to be prosecuted.

- 8. After escorting Ms. Carter and her mother back to their home and clearing the scene, the officers left. On their way out, they suggested that Ms. Carter "take a picture" of Defendant Leggett—who was on his way to Ms. Carter's home with a gun to murder her—if and when Defendant Leggett arrived in order to document the order of protection violation.
- 9. The officers' flagrant incompetence quickly and predictably resulted in Ms. Carter being murdered. "Approximately ten minutes" after the officers left the scene, Defendant Leggett showed up at Ms. Carter's home, kicked in the door, and shot her multiple times, killing her. See Ex. 2 at 12.
- 10. Following Ms. Carter's murder, one of the responding officers attempted to cover up what had happened by falsely reporting that Ms. Carter "DID NOT WISH TO PROSECUTE AT THIS TIME FOR THE ORDER OF PROTECTION VIOLATION" while claiming that "OFFICERS COULD NOT DO IT ON HER BEHALF." *See* Ex. 2 at 7. By contrast, another officer's post-homicide report accurately recounted that "MS. CARTER WAS INTERESTED IN PROSECUTING," *id.* at 18, but it falsely claimed that "OFFICERS WERE NOT ABLE TO VERIFY WITH ANYONE AT THE SCENE THAT THERE WAS A VIOLATION OF THE ORDER OF PROTECTION AND NOT ABLE TO PROSECUTE ON HER BEHALF." *Id.*
- 11. These statements were materially inaccurate. What actually occurred was that Ms. Carter—knowing that she was in serious danger, and appropriately relying on law enforcement to protect her from imminent and foreseeable harm—did everything that she was supposed to do within the law to ensure that law enforcement complied with its special duty to protect her from James Leggett. Thereafter, the Metropolitan Government's catastrophic negligence—which the responding officers dishonestly

attempted to conceal after Ms. Carter's murder—got Ms. Carter killed.

- 12. After Ms. Carter was shot by Defendant Leggett, officers took out warrants for an order of protection violation based on the text messages that Leggett had sent Ms. Carter—all of which Ms. Carter had shown them earlier in the day. *See id.* at 21. Contrary to their previous claims of impotence and prior representations that they could not prosecute an order of protection violation on their own, the warrants were obtained by the MNPD without involving Ms. Carter, who was on life support at the time. Thereafter, in the MNPD's view, the case was successfully "close[d]... as cleared by arrest." *Id.* Ms. Carter died several days later.
- 13. To honor Ms. Carter's beloved memory—and in the hopes of ensuring that no other parent experiences the anguish and loss associated with such a preventable death—this wrongful death action timely followed.

II. PARTIES

14. At the time of her death, decedent Michaela Carter was a beautiful 24-yearold woman with a full life ahead of her:



- 15. Plaintiff Kimberly Jones-Mbuyi is the mother of decedent Michaela Carter.

 Ms. Jones-Mbuyi is a citizen and resident of Davidson County, Tennessee. She may be contacted through counsel.
- 16. The Defendant Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County ("Metro") is a governmental entity that includes the Metropolitan Nashville Police Department. Metro can be served with process through any officer or managing agent thereof at the Metropolitan Department of Law, 1 Public Square, Nashville, Tennessee 37219.
- 17. Defendant James Leggett—Ms. Carter's murderer—is a resident of Davidson County, Tennessee. He is currently being held at Whiteville Correctional Facility, 1440 Union Springs Road, Whiteville, TN 38075, while awaiting trial for Ms. Carter's murder in Davidson County Criminal Court Case No. 2022-B-1229.

III. JURISDICTION, AUTHORITY AND VENUE

- 18. This Court has jurisdiction over this lawsuit pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 16-10-101.
- 19. Plaintiff Kimberly Jones-Mbuyi has the authority to bring this wrongful death action pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 20-5-107(a),¹ Tenn. Code Ann. § 5-1-105, Tenn. Code Ann. § 29-14-102, and Tenn. Code Ann. § 31-1-106(b)–(c).
- 20. As the county where the causes of action arose and where the Plaintiff and the Defendants reside, venue in this matter is proper pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 20-4-101(a).

¹ Ms. Carter's birth father having assigned the Plaintiff the exclusive right to pursue this wrongful death claim on the decedent's behalf, Ms. Jones-Mbuyi is the only proper plaintiff regarding this action. Ms. Carter's birth father is nonetheless being served notice of this proceeding.

IV. FACTUAL ALLEGATIONS

- 21. On July 18, 2021, Defendant Leggett brutally attacked Ms. Carter with a glass liquor bottle near downtown Nashville.
- 22. As a result of that attack, Ms. Carter was hospitalized for injuries caused by Defendant Leggett, and Defendant Leggett was arrested.
- 23. That same day, Ms. Carter petitioned for an order of protection against Defendant Leggett. Defendant Leggett was served with notice of Ms. Carter's petition while he was in custody, and a temporary order of protection was granted shortly thereafter.
- 24. On August 16, 2021, the Davidson County Circuit Court held a final hearing on Ms. Carter's Petition for Order of Protection. Following that hearing, Ms. Carter's Petition was granted. As such, a final order of protection issued against Defendant Leggett.
- 25. Ms. Carter's final order of protection took effect that same day, August 16,2021. The order was made effective for one year.
- 26. Ms. Carter's order of protection against Defendant Leggett ordered Defendant Leggett, among other things: (1) to have no contact with Ms. Carter, either directly or indirectly, including by phone or text message; and (2) to stay away from Ms. Carter's home. *See* Ex. 1 at 37. It further ordered that Defendant Leggett could not have, receive, or attempt to receive firearms. *See id.* at 38.
- 27. For approximately the next three months, Ms. Carter remained safe because Defendant Leggett was in custody.
- 28. In November 2021, and to Ms. Carter's shock and surprise, Defendant Leggett was released from custody.

- 29. Shortly after being released, on November 15, 2021, Defendant Leggett began harassing and threatening Ms. Carter via phone, text message, and social media. Defendant Leggett also set out looking for Ms. Carter while carrying a gun.
- 30. On November 15, 2021, Defendant Leggett published multiple ominous Facebook posts, including one stating that "[t]oday is the day" and another stating that "[s]omebody with nothing to lose won't give a fuck When Shit gets real don't ask me why[.]"
- 31. In direct violation of Ms. Carter's order of protection, Defendant Leggett called Ms. Carter repeatedly and sent her extensive text message correspondence. Defendant Leggett's text message correspondence—which included, among other things, a photo of Defendant Leggett and Ms. Carter and revenge pornography depicting them both—made obvious to anyone who viewed it that Defendant Leggett was the person responsible for sending the correspondence at issue to Ms. Carter.
- 32. On November 15, 2021, based on Defendant Leggett's behavior, Ms. Carter and her mother called 911 because they imminently feared for Ms. Carter's safety.
- 33. After officers arrived, Ms. Carter showed the responding officers the text messages that she had received from Defendant Leggett, she informed them that Defendant Leggett had been calling her, and she informed them that Defendant Leggett had been observed at a family member's apartment building with a gun, all of which violated Ms. Carter's order of protection.
- 34. Although the text messages originated from an unknown phone number, Ms. Carter showed the responding officers at least one message from the number that included a photo of Defendant Leggett with Ms. Carter and expressed accurate certainty that Defendant Leggett was responsible for sending the messages based on their personal

contents. Ms. Carter and her mother also informed officers that they recognized Defendant Leggett's voice from the phone calls received from the unknown phone number.

- 35. Ms. Carter additionally showed officers a text message from the number that included revenge pornography that only Defendant Leggett would have had access to and which Defendant Leggett had previously threatened to disseminate.
- 36. Despite: (1) Ms. Carter being "confident [the text messages] w[ere] from Mr. Leggett" due to their contents, including a photograph of Defendant Leggett with Ms. Carter and a video of the two of them that only Defendant Leggett possessed; and (2) the fact that Defendant Leggett had been observed with a gun in violation of Ms. Carter's order of protection, the responding MNPD officers claimed, falsely, that they "were not able to verify with anyone at the scene that there was a violation of the order of protection and not able to prosecute on [Ms. Carter's] behalf." See Ex. 2 at 18.
- 37. Despite Ms. Carter being "interested in prosecuting[,]" responding officers incorrectly indicated that they were unable to arrest Mr. Leggett, and they "provided her with information for DA screening" instead. *Id*.
- 38. The order of protection that Ms. Carter relied upon for her safety assured Ms. Carter that "if [James Leggett] comes around you, threatens you or bothers you he/she can be arrested by the Police Department **on the spot**." *See* Ex. 1 at 1 (emphasis added). Tennessee law supported that assurance. *See* Tenn. Code Ann. § 36-3-611(a) ("An arrest for violation of an order of protection issued pursuant to this part may be with or without warrant. Any law enforcement officer shall arrest the respondent without a warrant if: (1) The officer has proper jurisdiction over the area in which the violation occurred; (2) The officer has reasonable cause to believe the respondent has violated or is

in violation of an order for protection; and (3) The officer has verified whether an order of protection is in effect against the respondent. If necessary, the police officer may verify the existence of an order for protection by telephone or radio communication with the appropriate law enforcement department.").

- 39. Even so, the responding officers inaccurately told Ms. Carter that she would have to "go downtown" and swear out a warrant in order to have Defendant Leggett arrested, and they claimed that they were unable to take any action against Defendant Leggett unless and until she did so.
- 40. Still afraid for her life, Ms. Carter and the Plaintiff begged the responding officers to escort them home so they could safely retrieve personal items, including a driver's license that officers advised Ms. Carter she needed in order to file a police report downtown. Officers obliged but promptly left after they did not find Defendant Leggett at Ms. Carter's home. Before leaving, though, the responding officers inexplicably advised Ms. Carter that *if Defendant Leggett showed up to her home with a gun as she feared,* then she should take a photo of Defendant Leggett so that there would be sufficient evidence to support an order of protection violation.
- 41. "Approximately ten minutes" after the officers who responded to the Plaintiff's 911 call left the scene, Defendant Leggett showed up at the Plaintiff's home where Ms. Carter lived—carrying a gun—and kicked in the door. *See* Ex. 2 at 12. Upon entry, Defendant Leggett shot Ms. Carter and her stepfather multiple times. Ms. Carter died from her injuries several days later.
- 42. Ms. Carter did not have time to take a photo of Defendant Leggett before she was shot. Doing so also would not have protected her.
 - 43. Instead, cornered in a bedroom with her mother and stepfather, Defendant

Leggett intentionally shot Ms. Carter through the chest and leg. Defendant Leggett also intentionally shot Ms. Carter's stepfather in the leg, hand, and jaw.

- 44. After shooting Ms. Carter and her stepfather, Defendant Leggett fled the scene. He was apprehended by law enforcement a short time later.
- 45. During a subsequent interview with a detective, Defendant Leggett admitted "to the act of shooting the victim[.]" *Id.* at 12.
- 46. Defendant Leggett also admitted, after being Mirandized, that he had sent Ms. Carter the aforementioned text messages on November 15, 2021. *See id.* at 21.
- 47. Thereafter, officers took out warrants for the "order of protection violation for the text message sent by" Defendant Leggett. *Id*.
- 48. In the days following Ms. Carter's preventable murder, officers submitted irreconcilably conflicting and knowingly inaccurate reports regarding what occurred on November 15, 2021.
- 49. In an attempt to cover up the fatal negligence that resulted in Ms. Carter's preventable death, one officer prepared a report stating that although there had been an order of protection violation, Ms. Carter "did not wish to prosecute at this time for the order of protection violation, and officers could not do it on her behalf." *See* Ex. 2 at 7.
- 50. A different report reflected, correctly, that "Ms. Carter <u>was</u> interested in prosecuting[.]" *See id.* at 18 (emphasis added). In a separate attempt to cover up the fatal negligence that resulted in Ms. Carter's preventable death, though, that report falsely stated that "Officers were not able to verify with anyone at the scene that there was a violation of the order of protection" and "were not able to prosecute on [Ms. Carter's] behalf." *Id*.

V. CAUSES OF ACTION

<u>Count #1: Governmental Tort Liability Act—Negligence</u> (As to the Defendant Metropolitan Government)

- 51. The Plaintiff incorporates and realleges the foregoing allegations as if fully set forth herein.
- 52. Governmental entities are generally immune from liability for injuries resulting from their acts and omissions.
- 53. However, "[i]mmunity from suit of all governmental entities is removed for injury proximately caused by a negligent act or omission of any employee within the scope of his employment" *See* Tenn. Code Ann. § 29-20-205.
- 54. The officers who responded to Ms. Carter's and the Plaintiff's 911 call were, at all times relevant to this Complaint, acting within the scope of their employment by Defendant Metro.
- 55. When officers responded to Ms. Carter's and the Plaintiff's initial 911 call, they were presented with abundant and credible evidence that Defendant Leggett had repeatedly violated Ms. Carter's order of protection by texting and calling her and by carrying a firearm.
- 56. The responding officers verified that Ms. Carter did, in fact, have an active and valid order of protection pending against Defendant Leggett. *See* Ex. 2 at 18 ("The Order of Protection was verified with <u>DCSO</u>.").
- 57. Given such evidence, and in conjunction with an actively pending order of protection stemming from recent and violent abuse for which Defendant Leggett had only just been released from custody, it was reasonably foreseeable to a person of ordinary intelligence and prudence that Defendant Leggett had repeatedly violated Ms. Carter's order of protection; that he was subject to immediate arrest for doing so; and that he

posed an immediate threat of harm to Ms. Carter, specifically.

- 58. It was also reasonably foreseeable that Defendant Leggett would continue to violate Ms. Carter's order of protection if he was not apprehended and arrested. The responding officers specifically recognized this likelihood. Thus—notwithstanding the obvious danger of photographing an armed and violent person who had a recent history of harming her—the responding officers inexplicably advised Ms. Carter to document Defendant Leggett's future violations by photographing him when he appeared.
- 59. Notwithstanding Tenn. Code Ann. § 29-20-205's general removal of governmental immunity for negligent acts or omissions, the public duty doctrine² shields governmental entities from liability when the duty involved is owed to the public at large, rather than to an individual plaintiff.
- 60. The special duty exception, however, maintains liability notwithstanding the public duty doctrine in three situations. Two of those exceptions apply to this action.

i. Affirmative Undertaking and Reliance

- 61. The public duty doctrine is overcome by the special duty exception when "a public official affirmatively undertakes to protect the plaintiff and the plaintiff relies upon the undertaking." *See Brown v. Hamilton County*, 126 S.W.3d 43, 49 (Tenn. 2004).
- 62. The "existence of an order of protection" gives rise to such a special duty to protect under Tennessee law. *See Matthews v. Pickett Cnty.*, 996 S.W.2d 162, 163 (Tenn. 1999).
- 63. Further, failing to arrest an order of protection violator when Tenn. Code Ann. § 36-3-611(a) mandates such an arrest constitutes "a deviation from a policy as

² Although unnecessary to obtain relief, the Plaintiff expressly preserves the claim that the public duty doctrine should be overruled.

expressed by statutory mandate and [is] operational in nature." See Matthews, 996 S.W.2d at 164.

- 64. Ms. Carter obtained a final order of protection against Defendant Leggett in August of 2021 that was still pending and effective in November of 2021.
- 65. Ms. Carter's order of protection prominently advised Ms. Carter that if Leggett came around her, threatened her, or bothered her while the order of protection was in effect, he could "be arrested by the Police Department on the spot." *See* Ex. 1 at 1.
- 66. After Ms. Carter obtained her order of protection, Ms. Carter and the Plaintiff were also expressly advised that if Defendant Leggett contacted Ms. Carter by call or text message, such unauthorized contact would violate the order and immediately subject Defendant Leggett to 10 days in jail for each text message and phone call.
- 67. Ms. Carter relied on these advisories. These advisories were also the reason why Ms. Carter and the Plaintiff called 911 to secure Defendant Leggett's arrest when he violated Ms. Carter's order of protection.
- 68. Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 36-3-611(a), a "law enforcement officer **shall arrest** the respondent [to a petition for an Order of Protection] **without a warrant** if: (1) The officer has proper jurisdiction over the area in which the violation occurred; (2) The officer has reasonable cause to believe the respondent has violated or is in violation of an order of protection; and (3) The officer has verified whether an order of protection is in effect against the respondent." *Id.* (emphases added).
- 69. A willful violation of an order of protection also subjects a violator to immediate arrest and prosecution for criminal contempt, pursuant to which a violator must be taken before a magistrate without unnecessary delay. *See* Tenn. Code Ann. § 36-3-612(a) ("A person arrested for the violation of an order of protection issued pursuant to

this part or a restraining order or court-approved consent agreement, shall be taken before a magistrate or the court having jurisdiction in the cause without unnecessary delay to answer a charge of contempt for violation of the order of protection, restraining order or court-approved consent agreement ").

- 70. Given the foregoing—and notwithstanding the responding officers' inaccurate claims to the contrary—it was not necessary for Ms. Carter to "go downtown," to file a police report, or to swear out a warrant in order to secure Mr. Leggett's arrest. Instead, showing the responding officers her order of protection, providing them abundant evidence that Mr. Leggett had willfully violated it, and reporting that Mr. Leggett had been observed carrying a firearm in violation of Ms. Carter's order of protection were more than sufficient.
- 71. Despite the criteria of Tenn. Code Ann. § 36-3-611(a) having been satisfied, and despite Defendant Leggett's criminal contempt of Ms. Carter's order of protection, the responding officers failed to arrest Defendant Leggett, and they inaccurately indicated that they were unable to do so.
- 72. Instead, the responding officers joked about the situation before instructing Ms. Carter to "go downtown" to swear out a warrant herself.
- 73. By obtaining an order of protection, Ms. Carter affirmatively relied on Metro to protect her from Defendant Leggett, and Metro had a special duty to do so.
- 74. Ms. Carter's order of protection required the Metropolitan Government to arrest Defendant Leggett under the circumstances that preceded Ms. Carter's death.
- 75. The officers of the Metropolitan Government failed to protect Ms. Carter from the foreseeable harm posed by Defendant Leggett.
 - 76. The officers of the Metropolitan Government failed to arrest Defendant

Leggett despite his multiple violations of Ms. Carter's order of protection.

- 77. The officers of the Metropolitan Government instead gave Ms. Carter inaccurate information regarding their purported inability to effectuate an arrest and prosecution of Defendant Leggett, and they affirmatively advised Ms. Carter to photograph Defendant Leggett if he showed up at her home.
- 78. Due to Ms. Carter's affirmative reliance on Metro officers to act pursuant to the order of protection and their statutory obligations to effectuate an immediate arrest, and due to Ms. Carter's affirmative reliance on Metro officers' fatal advice to photograph Defendant Leggett instead of immediately seeking safety until he was apprehended and arrested, Ms. Carter was foreseeably killed by Defendant Leggett.

ii. Reckless Conduct

- 79. The public duty doctrine is independently overcome by the special duty exception when "a plaintiff alleges a cause of action involving . . . reckless misconduct." *Brown*, 126 S.W.3d at 49.
- 80. "Reckless conduct is defined as taking place 'when a person is aware of, but consciously disregards, a substantial and unjustifiable risk of such a nature that its disregard constitutes a gross deviation from the standard of care that an ordinary person would exercise under all the circumstances." *Id.* (quoting *Gardner v. Insura Property & Cas. Ins. Co.*, 956 S.W.2d 1, 3 (Tenn. Ct. App. 1997)).
- 81. Here, in the alternative, the responding officers' failure to meaningfully investigate the alarming text messages presented by Ms. Carter or the report that Defendant Leggett was roaming a family member's apartment building with a gun—combined with their affirmative advice to photograph a known-to-be-armed-and-dangerous Defendant Leggett if he appeared—amounted to reckless conduct.

- 82. At the time officers responded to Ms. Carter's and the Plaintiff's initial 911 call, there was a substantial risk that Defendant Leggett was searching for Ms. Carter for the purpose of murdering her.
- 83. Officers ignored that risk by failing to secure Ms. Carter's safety before Defendant Leggett was apprehended, by quickly leaving Ms. Carter's home before Defendant Leggett's whereabouts were ascertained, and by inexplicably advising Ms. Carter to photograph a known-to-be-armed-and-dangerous Defendant Leggett if and when he arrived.
- 84. As a result of the Metropolitan Government's recklessness, Ms. Carter was predictably murdered.

* * *

- 85. Metro's immunity for negligence having been removed, and the public duty doctrine being inapplicable, the Plaintiff's claims of negligence are properly asserted against Metro directly, rather than against the individual officers. *See* Tenn. Code Ann. § 29–20–310(b).
 - 86. Defendant Metro owed a duty of care to Ms. Carter.
- 87. With an active order of protection in place against Defendant Leggett, and with credible proof that Defendant Leggett was actively communicating with and attempting to come about Ms. Carter while armed in violation of that order of protection, Defendant Metro was obligated to apprehend and arrest Defendant Leggett.
- 88. At minimum, Defendant Metro had a duty to meaningfully investigate the alarming text messages that Ms. Carter showed officers and to ensure her safety until Defendant Leggett was apprehended.
 - 89. Defendant Metro breached its duty of care to Ms. Carter.

- 90. Defendant Metro failed to act reasonably and in a manner that met the standard of care required by its duty to protect Ms. Carter.
- 91. As a result of Metro's breach of its duty of care, Ms. Carter was foreseeably murdered.
- 92. As a result of Metro's breach of its duty of care, the Plaintiff suffered massive damages, including the wrongful death of her beloved daughter, extreme pain and suffering, loss of filial consortium, and property damage to her home.

Count #2: Battery (As to Defendant Leggett)

- 93. The Plaintiff incorporates and realleges the foregoing allegations as if fully set forth herein.
- 94. "[B]attery is an intentional tort under Tennessee law." *Brown v. Christian Bros. Univ.*, 428 S.W.3d 38, 57 (Tenn. Ct. App. 2013).
- 95. To recover for battery, a plaintiff must show: (1) that there was "an unpermitted touching of the plaintiff[,]" and (2) that the unpermitted touching was done "by the defendant or by some object set in motion by the defendant." *Cary v. Arrowsmith*, 777 S.W.2d 8, 21 (Tenn. Ct. App. 1989).
- 96. On November 15, 2021, Defendant Leggett intentionally—and without provocation or justification—set multiple bullets in motion toward Ms. Carter and her stepfather by discharging them from a firearm.
 - 97. Defendant Leggett intentionally shot Ms. Carter multiple times, killing her.
 - 98. Defendant Leggett admitted shooting Ms. Carter.
 - 99. Ms. Carter did not permit Defendant Leggett to shoot her.
- 100. As a result of Defendant Leggett's battery, Ms. Carter was severely injured, hospitalized, and ultimately killed.

Count #3: Declaratory Judgment (As to Defendant Leggett)

- 101. The Plaintiff incorporates and realleges the foregoing allegations as if fully set forth herein.
- 102. At the time of Ms. Carter's murder, Ms. Carter was estranged from—but legally married to—Defendant Leggett.
- 103. As Ms. Carter's spouse at the time of her death, Defendant Leggett would normally serve as Ms. Carter's next-of-kin.
- Ms. Carter, his legal wife, Defendant Leggett has forfeited all benefits with respect to Ms. Carter's estate and eliminated any right he otherwise would have had to file or maintain an action for Ms. Carter's wrongful death. *See generally* Tenn. Code Ann. § 31-1-106(b)–(c). *See also House v. Gibson*, 827 S.W.2d 310, 311 (Tenn. Ct. App. 1991) ("in the event the surviving spouse is found to have intentionally caused the death of his or her spouse, T.C.A. § 31–1–106 excludes the surviving spouse as a beneficiary of a cause of action for wrongful death.").
- 105. Defendant Leggett is currently incarcerated and awaiting trial on multiple charges, including two felony counts of criminal homicide for murdering Ms. Carter. Further, although Defendant Leggett has not yet been found guilty of criminal homicide, he has admitted to "the act of shooting [Ms. Carter]." *See* Ex. 2 at 12.
- 106. Accordingly, a declaratory judgment should issue that declares that Defendant Leggett has forfeited all benefits with respect to Ms. Carter's estate and eliminated any right he otherwise would have had to file or maintain an action for Ms. Carter's wrongful death.

VI. PRAYER FOR RELIEF

WHEREFORE, the Plaintiff respectfully requests:

- 1. That the Defendants be required to appear and answer this Complaint within the time required by law;
- 2. A maximum award of damages for wrongful death and damage to personal property under the GTLA against Defendant Metro following a bench trial as to that claim;
- 3. An award of compensatory damages against Defendant Leggett in an amount not less than \$10,000,000.00;
- 4. An award of punitive damages against Defendant Leggett in an amount not less than \$20,000,000.00;
- 5. That the Plaintiff be awarded the discretionary costs of trying this action;
- 6. That pre-judgment and post-judgment interest be awarded to the Plaintiff;
- 7. That all costs be taxed against the Defendants;
- 8. That a jury of 12 be empaneled to try all claims so triable; and
- 9. All such further relief as this Court deems just and proper.





NARRATIVE (REQUIRED)

ON 11/15/2021 SOUTH OFFICERS WERE DISPATCHED TO 608 VANNA CT. THE VICTIM LIVES AT THIS LOCATION WITH HER PARENTS. OFFICERS WERE OUT AT THE LOCATION TAKING A DOMESTIC RELATED REPORT OF AN ORDER OF PROTECTION VIOLATION.
APPROXIMATELY TEN MINUTES AFTER LEAVING, POLICE WERE CALLED BACK TO THE SCENE WHEN THE SUSPECT APPEARED OUTSIDE THE HOME WITH A GUN. HE THEN KICKED IN THE DOOR AND OPENED FIRE ON THE VICTIM AND HER FATHER. THE SUSPECT FLED THE SCENE BUT EMERGED FROM THE WOODS SURRENDERING HIMSELF TO POLICE SOMETIME LATER AFTER POLICE SATURATED THE AREA. THE VICTIM AND HER FATHER WERE TRANSPORTED TO VANDERBILT. THE VICTIM WAS PRONOUNCED BRAIN DEAD ON 11/17/21. SHE WAS KEPT ALIVE FOR ORGAN DONATION PURPOSES AFTER REMOVED FROM LIFE SUPPORT ON 11/22/21. PRIOR TO THE VICTIM???S DEATH, DOMESTIC VIOLENCE DETECTIVE COWPER WAS THE LEAD INVESTIGATOR. THE FIREARM WAS NOT LOCATED ON THE DAY OF THE INCIDENT. IT WAS FOUND ON 11/16/21 UTILIZING AN AFF K9. THE SUSPECT ADMITTED DURING THE COURSE OF AN INTERVIEW WITH DETECTIVE COWPER TO THE ACT OF SHOOTING THE VICTIM AND AS TO THE APPROXIMATE LOCATION OF THE FIREARM IN THE WOODED AREA. HE WOULD NOT ADMIT HIS MOTIVE. THE FIREARM IS CURRENTLY IN THE POSSESSION OF FORENSIC SERVICES AND BEING COMPARED TO THE PROJECTILE RECOVERED FROM THE SCENE. THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE WAS MADE AWARE THAT THE VICTIM EXPIRED AND THAT THE CHARGE NEEDS TO BE AMENDED TO CRIMINAL HOMICIDE.


